Current Library 17k sq. ft.

New Library 38k sq. ft.



Adult Collection

8k sq. ft. across two floors.

Adult Collection

12k sq. ft. all one more floor for improved accessibility.



Children's Area

2,450 sq. ft. with undersized Activity Room.

Children's Area

8,300 sq. ft. with a Multi-Purpose Room, Mother's Room, Family Restroom, etc.



Study Rooms

Four rooms with a combined 550 sq. ft.

Study Rooms

Six rooms with a combined 1,200 sq. ft.



Teen Room

Shared space with 500 sq. ft.

Teen Room

Dedicated space with 750 sq. ft., Large enough for group study and after school events.



Multi-Purpose Space

One room of 1k sq. ft.

Multi-Purpose Space

Flexible spaces that can combine as needed. Total of 4,100k sq. ft.

Makerspace

No dedicated space currently.

Makerspace

1,200 sq. ft. dedicated to STEAM activities for all ages.



Quiet Space

No truly dedicated space for this currently.

Quiet Space

400 sq. ft. dedicated to silent activities like reading, studying, and remote work.



Sensory Rooms

No dedicated space currently.

Sensory Rooms

Quiet, calm space designed for individuals with sensory processing needs.



Computer Area

525 sq. ft. with limited space for one-on-one assistance.

Computer Area

700 sq. ft. with expanded services like digitization and resume help.



Coffee Shop

No dedicated space, just a vending machine.

Coffee Shop

1,200 sq. ft. partnership with local company. Would generate revenue for library.



Outdoor Space

One pavilion of 900 sq. ft.

Outdoor Space

Multiple zones intentionally designed for reading, learning, and other activities

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
